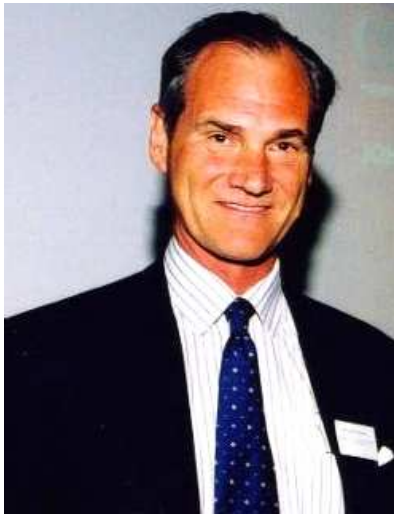


## **BIOGRAPHICAL DETAILS - PROFESSOR GUILLEBAUD**

Current Hon Community Consultant in Reproductive Health, Oxford, and vasectomy surgeon (since 1970) at the Churchill Hospital, Oxford. Consultant for WHO and other international and national bodies. Regular speaker to doctors and nurses in the UK and invited lecturer to about 50 countries in every continent, on contraceptive technology and related issues. Author of seven books and c 300 other publications: on birth control, reproductive health, population and environmental sustainability.
